

Benefits of Using Alberta Pardons

Application Processor

Time to Get Certified Record

Yourself	Usually 6 to 12 months.
Other Companies	Usually 6 to 12 months.
Alberta Pardons	Usually 1 to 3 months (when biometrically fingerprinted).

Priority Service Charge

Yourself	NA
Other Companies	\$300 to \$500 (whether or not it will help).
Alberta Pardons	\$120 (only if qualified by National Parole Board Rules and Regulations).

Letter to Your Potential Employer or Current Employer, stating you will soon be Pardoned

Yourself	NA
Other Companies	YES, but for an additional fee.
Alberta Pardons	YES, at no extra charge (only upon request).

Email Updates (whenever something happens with your file)

Court and Police Records

Yourself	May have to attend some or all Court Houses and Police Stations in person.
Other Companies	May have to attend some or all Court Houses and Police Stations in person.
Alberta Pardons	All documents are obtained by Alberta Pardons via a Notary Public or a Commissioner of Oaths.* * Some small town Alberta RCMP detachments demand that the client submit requests and retrieve Police Records in person, irregardless of what legal documents they receive.

US Waiver Needed to go to the United States, at a cost of \$1200.00 for the 1st year, and thousands more in the future.
